By taking specialty classes with an experienced instructor, you will increase diving skills and comfortability, opening the door to new diving adventures.

Many specialties are earned in as little as 1to 2 more dives. When you have completed four specialties and logged a minimal number of logged dives you can qualify for higher SDI Advanced Diver rating. Add Rescue Diver and more dives and you qualify for either a PADI or SDI coveted Master Diver rating.
